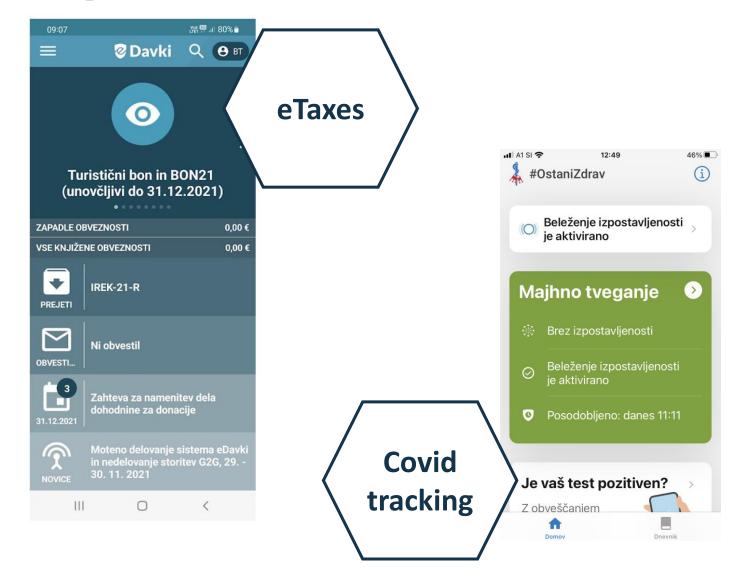

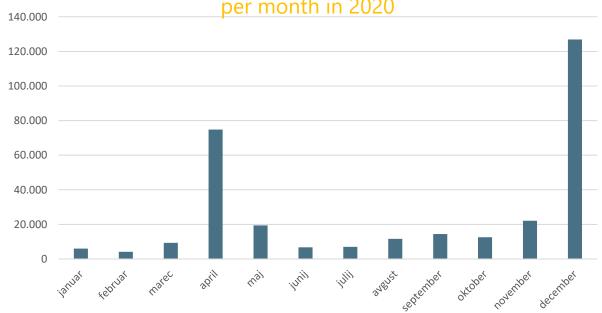

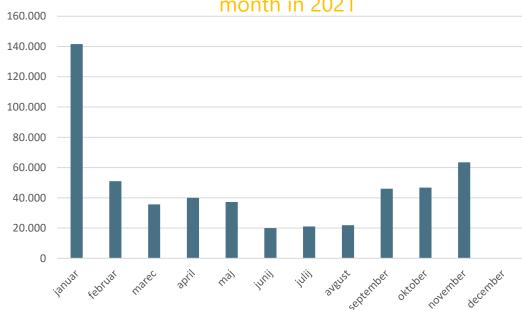

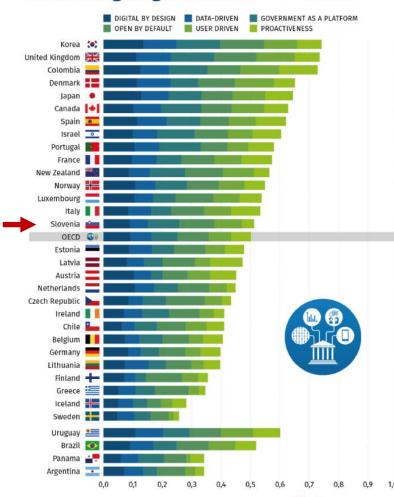
Number of applications submitted per month in 2021



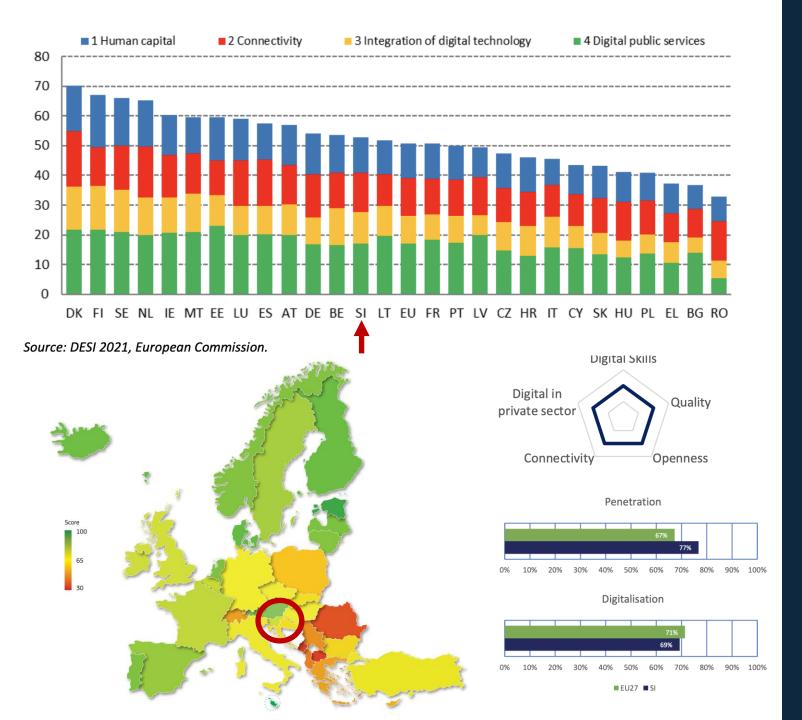

How are countries progressing towards digital government?



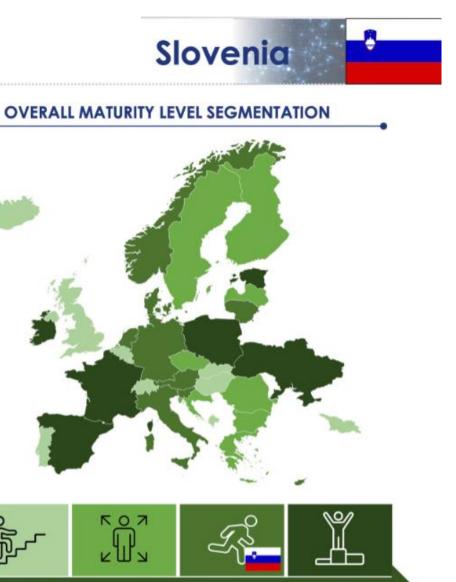

- **Strategy of Digital Public Services 2021 2030** supporting the digital transformation for better, more efficient, friendly and trustworthy public services.

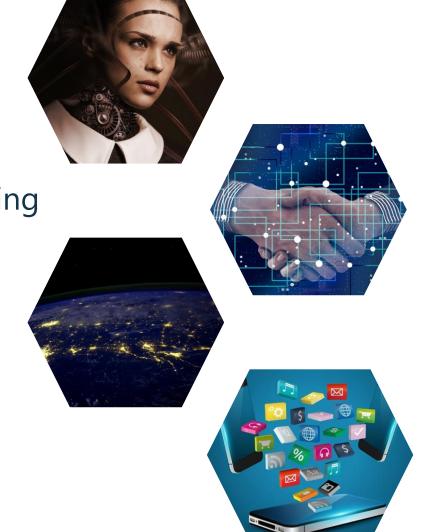
