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**COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING DECISION**

**of 11.12.2017**

**amending Commission Decision C(2015)1658 approving the national programme of Slovenia for support from the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund for the period from 2014 to 2020**

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**amending Commission Decision C(2015)1658 approving the national programme of Slovenia for support from the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund for the period from 2014 to 2020**

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THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 514/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 April 2014 laying down general provisions on the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund and on the instrument for financial support for police cooperation, preventing and combating crime, and crisis management<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 14(9) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Commission Decision C(2015)1658 approved the national programme of Slovenia for support from the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund for the period 2014 to 2020 submitted on 13 March 2015 and set the maximum contribution from the Fund to the national programme of Slovenia.
- (2) In accordance with Article 1 of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 801/2014<sup>2</sup>, Member States should provide every two years the number of persons they plan to resettle.
- (3) Member States are entitled to receive an additional amount of EUR 6 000 for each resettled person referred to in Article 17(1) of Regulation (EU) No 516/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council<sup>3</sup>, and EUR 10 000 for each resettled person referred to in Article 17(2) of that Regulation.
- (4) On 30 November 2017, Slovenia submitted, through the Commission's electronic data exchange system (SFC2014), a revised national programme to provide for an estimate of the number of persons it plans to resettle.

(5) This Decision constitutes a financing decision within the meaning of Article 84 of Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council<sup>4</sup> and a legal commitment within the meaning of Article 85 of that Regulation.

(6) Decision C(2015)1658 should therefore be amended accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

*Article 1*

Decision C(2015)1658 is amended as follows:

(1) Article 1 is replaced by the following:

*"Article 1*

The revised national programme of Slovenia for support from the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund for the period from 1 January 2014 to 31 December 2020, as submitted in its final version on 30 November 2017, is hereby approved."

(2) Article 2 is replaced by the following:

*"Article 2*

1. The maximum contribution from the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund to the national programme of Slovenia is set at EUR 20 328 072 to be financed from budget line 18 03 01 of the general budget of the Union.
2. The maximum contribution shall be composed of:
  - (a) a basic amount of EUR 14 725 477 allocated in accordance with Annex I to Regulation (EU) No 516/2014;
  - (b) an additional amount of EUR 600 000 for the Union Resettlement Programme, allocated in accordance with Article 17 of that Regulation;
  - (c) an additional amount of EUR 3 402 000 for the relocation of applicants for international protection from Greece and Italy in accordance with Article 10 of Council Decision (EU) 2015/1523<sup>5</sup> and Article 10(1)(a) of Council Decision (EU) 2015/1601<sup>6</sup>;
  - (d) an additional amount of EUR 1 600 595 allocated in accordance with Annex I to Regulation (EU) No 516/2014."
